The Tender Operations Platform (TOP) is an ESCB system that supports the implementation of the ECB monetary policy through the processing of ECB open market tender operations and the collection, and consolidation of bids received in a decentralized manner by euro area NCB. TOP has been developed by the Oesterreichische Nationalbank (OeNB).

The log-in/log-out times via the user's IAM (Identity Access Management) ID and detail of actions which have been carried out in the system are captured to ensure an accurate audit trail.
