Thank you very much for your letter of 20th March 1992 in which you suggest establishing an informal exchange of views on a regular basis between your services at the Commission and the Economic Unit, regarding the elaboration of world economic forecasts.

At present, contacts in this area take place through the participation of the Commission in the meetings of the Monetary Policy Sub-Committee of the Committee of Governors as well as through our presence as observers in the Commission's bi-annual forecasting meetings with national experts. I agree with you that efforts should continue to be made to further the exchange of views between our services through the existing channels. Unfortunately, calendar difficulties and existing working commitments prevent the Economic Unit from getting more intensively involved in the near future in world economic forecasting.
