Re: Your letter (QZ-004)

Honourable Member of the European Parliament, dear Mr Pedicini,

Thank you for your letter on the suitability criteria established by Directive 2013/36/EU ("CRD IV")¹, transposed into Italian law, which was passed on to me by Ms Irene Tinagli, Chair of the Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs, accompanied by a cover letter dated 19 January 2021.

With respect to the specific appointment referred to in your letter, please note that I cannot comment on the actions of individual credit institutions as the ECB is subject to professional secrecy requirements as outlined in CRD IV.

With respect to the legislative change referred to in your letter, please note that, pursuant to Article 4(1)(c) and the first sub-paragraph of Article 4(3) of Regulation (EU) No 1024/2013², the ECB assesses appointees on the basis of the applicable national legislation transposing CRD IV. The requirements under Italian Decree No 169/2020 of 23 November 2020 apply exclusively to appointments occurring after 30 December 2020.³ Therefore, this legislative change does not affect the assessment of appointments made before this date, which were carried out on the basis of the Italian legislation in force at the time.
