Description of Request:

The aim is to correct some discrepancies to the document such as figures, user requirement reference ID, function reference ID and deletion of some definitions.

The changes to the BFD address the following:

- a. Align the description of logical navigation paths described in the BFD and the implemented access paths in the T2S GUI screens.
- b. Refining the description of the search criteria in query functions
- c. Amending of the BFD functions
- d. Accessibility of the BFD functions via different T2S GUI screens.

The GUI BFD has to be updated for the following Clarifications, Implementation discrepancies with respect to the UHB and delete certain functions which are no more valid:

- 1. <u>Clarification: Collateralisation Eligibility of Securities cannot be accessed in the Securities reference detail screens. This functionality is covered by Collateralisation Eligibility query</u>
- 2. <u>The Security CSD Link can be amended to update the Valid-to date only to close it, the possibility to change the link type is not possible.</u>
- 3. <u>Clarification: There is no direct access from the screen of Security CSD links to Security MSA and Security restrictions.</u>
- 4. <u>Collateralisation Eligibility of Securities Account cannot be accessed in the Securities Account reference</u> <u>data. This functionality can be accessed via the CMB Securities Account Link query.</u>
- 5. The Amend Collateralisation Eligibility details functionality does not exist.
- 6. The deletion of Collateralisation Eligibility of Securities Account functionality does not exist.
- 7. Only deleting and recreating the close link is possible, amending the Close Link detail is not possible.

- 13. <u>It is not possible to search for secured elements independently. Querying of secured groups and then</u> display the secured elements is only possible.
- 14. <u>Clarification: The Roles New/edit screen does not have the option to go to the Grant/Revoke Privileges</u> screen and see which privileges have been granted (as is stated in figure 4-49). The Amend Role function does not allow changing the set of system and objecting privileges assign to a role. This functionality is covered by Grant/Revoke Privilege to a Role.
- 15. <u>It is not foreseen to display all the details such as: VAT, Service Item Group, scale/unit billing frequency</u> <u>under "Display Service Item Details".</u>
- 16. <u>Direct link of the function "Add Settlement Instruction or Settlement Restriction -</u> <u>T2S.GUI.SESE.INX.0070" and the "Display Securities Account positions" and "Display T2S Dedicated</u> <u>Cash Account Balances" does not exist.</u>
