# Reason for change and expected benefits/business motivation:

As per UDFS chapter 3.2.2.3, the T2S statement of transactions, i.e. the semt.017 message, can be subject to pagination. Pagination is applied at the level of the first repetitive element:

• The splitting for semt.017 is done on element SctiesTxPstngRpt/FinInstrmDtls.

Within the <FinInstrmDtls> sequence, T2S first reports the ISIN, and then all transactions settled in this ISIN in the repetitive transactions sequence <Tx>. A transaction within this sequence will typically amount for roughly 1.3 kb, with some variation depending on how much party information is added. All those transactions in the same ISIN will be reported in the same page of the semt.017.

This implies that, if, for a given business day, a large number of instructions in the same ISIN settle on the same account, then the aggregate size of the related transaction information might exceed the 32 MB limit that can be reported in the same page (it is assumed that for average size, this would occur at roughly 25.000 transactions. In case the instructions contain much optional information, the number can be significantly smaller).

In this case, T2S is not able to generate the semt.017 for the affected account, leading to incomplete reconciliation at the T2S Actor side. This is even more critical as the reconciliation would not be possible for the accounts with the highest activities, i.e. where it would be needed most.

# Description of requested change:

Pagination of semt.017 should be applied as transaction level, i.e. on element SctiesTxPstngRpt/FinInstrmDtls/Tx.

#### Proposed wording for the Change request:

(i) Update of UDFS Chapter 3.2.2.3 Outbound traffic exceeding given size limitations

Wording proposal to be included into UDFS:

In order to indicate that a report was split, the message elements foreseen to indicate "pagination" is used (<Pgntn> ... </Pgntn>) or for camt.053 <MsgPgntn>...</MsgPgntn>). Excepting the camt.053, reda.012<u>and semt.017</u> messages are split at the first level of repetitive elements.

The splitting for reda.009 is done on element SctyActvtyAdvc/SctyActvty/Chng. The splitting for reda.021 is done on element SctiesAcctRpt/RptOrErr/SctiesAcctRpt. The splitting for reda.035 is done on element SctiesAcctActvtyAdvc/SctiesAcctActvty/Chng. The splitting for semt.002 is done on element SctiesBalCtdyRpt/BalForAcct. The splitting for semt.017 is done on element SctiesTxPstngRpt/FinInstrmDtls. The splitting for semt.018 is done on element SctiesTxPdgRpt/Txs.

For semt.017 a specific procedure for splitting has been implemented. In order to avoid message parts exceeding 32 MB, the semt.017 is split at element SctiesTxPstngRpt/FinInstrmDtls/Tx.

(ii) Update of message documentation of semt.017

The message documentation for semt.017 (no schema impact) should be enriched: Inclusion of specific information at level < SctiesTxPstngRpt/FinInstrmDtls/Tx > where pagination is applied.

# High level description of Impact:

#### **Outcome/Decisions:**

\* CRG meeting on 24 January 2017: The CRG recommended to launch the detailed assessment of the Change Request and asked the 4CB to check the feasibility to deliver the Change Request in the T2S Release 1.3 (or earlier).

\* Advisory Group on 02 February 2017: In a written procedure from 26 January 2017 to 02 February 2017, the Advisory Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.

\* Advisory Group on Market Infrastructures for Securities and Collateral (AMI-SeCo) on 16 March 2017: Following a written procedure from 10 to 16 March 2017, the AMI-SeCo was in favour of approving the Change Request and its inclusion in T2S Release 1.3.

\* CSD Steering Group on 17 March 2017: Following a written procedure from 10 to 17 March 2017, the CSG adopted the resolution to approve the Change Request and its inclusion in T2S Release 1.3.
