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### 1. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA AND INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

The participants will be invited to agree on the present agenda.

The participants agreed to the proposed agenda.

### 2. OUTCOME OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING AND ACTION POINTS

The participants will be invited to approve the outcome of the previous meeting and to go through the list of Action Points.

The participants approved the outcome of the PMG meeting held on 23 February 2018 and agreed to publish it.

### **3. T2S RELEASES AND MIGRATIONS PLANNING AND MONITORING**

#### **3.1 Status update**

The Eurosystem will provide a high level status update on the T2S releases. The participants will be invited to discuss the issues/status/risks and to monitor the implementation of the various response plans.

The participants took note of the information provided and received the confirmation that the ISSG is closely monitoring the T2S operational risks with a cyber security background (i.e. risk IDs 52, 73 and 74).

#### **3.2 Planning and reporting**

This is part of the regular update of the Annexes to Schedule 2. The participants will be invited to endorse the updated Annexes 01, 02, 03 and 08.

The participants endorsed the proposed update of the Annexes 1, 2, 3 and 8 of Schedule 2 to the FA/CPA.

#### **3.3 User Testing and Migration activities**

The Eurosystem will provide an update on the User Testing activities and a status update on migration activities including planning of coming migrations. The PMG will receive the outcome of the cleaning exercise conducted for EAC, including a proposal for an updated schedule and the result of the clean-up exercise.

The participants:

- approved the concept for the User Testing framework, without discussing if this framework should be a single document or a set of documents;
- approved the proposed update of the EAC operating day schedule, with an implementation date as of 07 May 2018;
- welcomed the cleaning of EAC and asked if it would be possible to receive a further update of the impact this cleaning is having on the volumes related to reporting;
- were invited to comment on the draft version of the *DKK Migration to T2S – Migration and User Testing strategy* within a week following this meeting. This document will then be further updated based on the amended testing calendar updates from ID2S; and
- agreed to receive the next update of the migration strategy with its annexes at the latest by early June 2018. This update would also support the approval of ID2S as an active participant to this migration.

During the tour de table, both the Danish and ID2S representatives confirmed their ability to meet the migration deadline. The feedback from the recent MWDR was positive. One of the key elements to follow up is to clarify the role of the DCPs during the migration weekend itself.

The Irish CB also confirmed that everything was on track to allow for their testing to start in autumn 2018.

### **3.4 Update of the T2S STP**

The Eurosystem will provide a status update on the Service Transition Plans for various releases. The participants will be invited to discuss and approve the CR-520, CR-542, CR-543, CR-587, CR-590 and CR-670 to Release 3.0.

The participants endorsed the STPs for R.2.0, R.2.1, R.2.3 and R.3.0 as baseline.

The participants endorsed the allocation of the CR-520, CR-542, CR-543, CR-587 and CR-590 to the R.3.0. Regarding the CR-670, the participants endorsed its allocation to the R.3.0 pending the positive feedback from the CRG on the exact content of this CR to be provided on 20 April 2018.

## **4. UPDATE ON OTHER GROUPS ACTIVITIES**

### **4.1 Release Management Sub-Group - RMSG**

The Eurosystem will provide an oral update on the RMSG activities. The feedback from Steering Level (i.e. CSG, MIB) regarding the Operational Governance Framework will be shared with participants of the meeting.
